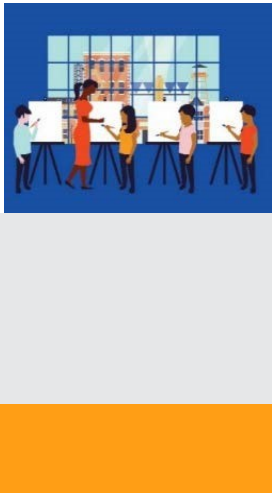




The National Endowment for the Arts is the only funder, public or private, that supports the arts in all **50 States** in the United States.

In the past 5 years... The National Endowment for the Arts distributed more than **\$4,869,500** in grants in **Indiana**.



In one year alone...

- Arts and cultural production in Indiana added **2.4%**, or **\$8.3 billion** to the state's economy.
- Indiana's arts and cultural industries employ **95,956** workers. These workers earn wages and benefits totaling **\$4.6 billion**.
- **35.9%** of Indiana's adults attended live music, theater, or dance performances, while **18.6%** attended art exhibits.

National Endowment for the Arts Programs from FY16-FY18

The **Blue Star Museums** program provided free admission to thousands of active military personnel and their families at **126 participating museums** in Indiana.

The **Poetry Out Loud** is a national competition which develops communication skills, presence, and confidence through the study, memorization, and public recitation of poetry. In Indiana, over **4,310 students** participated from among **66** high schools.

The **Big Read** program generated **245** community events focused on reading outstanding American literature and involving more than **10,880** adults and students in Indiana.

The **Shakespeare in American Communities** program enabled schools in Indiana to offer **7,800** children the opportunity to see free live professional performances of Shakespeare.

The **Creative Forces** program is expanding access to creative arts therapies and arts engagement opportunities for injured service members, veterans, and their families and caregivers.
