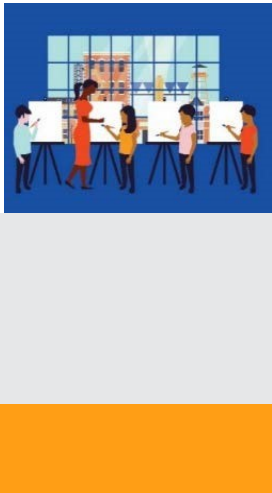




The National Endowment for the Arts is the only funder, public or private, that supports the arts in all **50 States** in the United States.

In the past 5 years... The National Endowment for the Arts distributed more than **\$2,978,700** in grants in **Nevada**.



In one year alone...

- Arts and cultural production in Nevada added **4.7%**, or **\$7.0 billion** to the state's economy.
- Nevada's arts and cultural industries employ **41,308** workers. These workers earn wages and benefits totaling **\$3.1 billion**.
- **29.6%** of Nevada's adults attended live music, theater, or dance performances, while **11.9%** attended art exhibits.

National Endowment for the Arts Programs from FY16-FY18

The **Blue Star Museums** program provided free admission to thousands of active military personnel and their families at **31 participating museums** in Nevada.

The **Poetry Out Loud** is a national competition which develops communication skills, presence, and confidence through the study, memorization, and public recitation of poetry. In Nevada, over **9,240 students** participated from among **96** high schools.

The **Big Read** program generated **34** community events focused on reading outstanding American literature and involving more than **2,060** adults and students in Nevada.

The **Shakespeare in American Communities** program enabled schools to offer children the opportunity to see free live professional performances of Shakespeare.

The **Creative Forces** program is expanding access to creative arts therapies and arts engagement opportunities for injured service members, veterans, and their families and caregivers.
