

# **VIRGINIA**



The National Endowment for the Arts is the only funder, public or private, that supports the arts in all **50 States** in the United States.

## In the past 5 years...

The National Endowment for the Arts distributed more than \$7,503,300 in grants in Virginia.



In one year alone...

- Arts and cultural production in Virginia added 3.4%, or
  \$17.0 billion to the state's economy.
- Virginia's arts and cultural industries employ **120,016** workers. These workers earn wages and benefits totaling **\$8.0 billion**.
- **38.2**% of Virginia's adults attended live music, theater, or dance performances, while **28.7**% attended art exhibits.

#### National Endowment for the Arts Programs from FY16-FY18

The **Blue Star Museums** program provided free admission to thousands of active military personnel and their families at **232** participating museums in Virginia.

The **Poetry Out Loud** is a national competition which develops communication skills, presence, and confidence through the study, memorization, and public recitation of poetry. In Virginia, over **23,330 students** participated from among **171** high schools.

The **Big Read** program generated **412** community events focused on reading outstanding American literature and involving more than **17,500** adults and students in Virginia.

The **Shakespeare in American Communities** program enabled schools in Virginia to offer **5,800** children the opportunity to see free live professional performances of Shakespeare.

The **Creative Forces** program is expanding access to creative arts therapies and arts engagement opportunities for injured service members, veterans, and their families and caregivers. Fort Belvoir and Navy Medical Center are participating in this innovative program.
