### IN THE PAST 5 YEARS...

The National Endowment for the Arts distributed more than **\$9,149,700** in grants in **Michigan**.

In one year alone...

- Arts and cultural production in Michigan added **2.8% or \$13.9 billion** to the state's economy.
- Michigan's arts and cultural industries employed **121,330** workers. These workers earned wages and benefits totaling over **\$7.6 billion**.
- **54.3%** of Michigan's adults attended live music, theater, or dance performances, while **29.8%** attended art exhibits.



### National Endowment for the Arts Programs from FY17-FY19

**Blue Star Museums** program provided free admission to thousands of active military personnel and their families at **155 participating museums** in Michigan.



**Poetry Out Loud** program provided opportunities for over **27,672 students** attending **129 high schools** in Michigan to appreciate—through study, memorization, and public recitation—great poetry.



The **NEA Big Read** program generated **530** community events focused on reading outstanding American literature and involving more than **39,380** adults and students in Michigan.



**Shakespeare in American Communities** program in Michigan enabled schools to offer children the opportunity to see free live professional performances of Shakespeare.



**Creative Forces** program is expanding access to creative arts therapies and arts engagement opportunities for injured service members, veterans, and their families and caregivers.

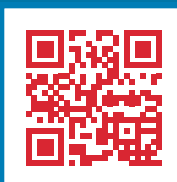
