In one year alone...

- Arts and cultural production in Delaware added 1.4% or \$1.1 billion to the state's economy.
- Delaware's arts and cultural industries employed 8,854 workers. These workers earned wages and benefits totaling over \$.5 billion.
- 45% of Delaware's adults attended live music, theatre, or dance performances, and 21.8% attended art exhibits.
