- Arts and cultural production in Oregon added
 3.5% or \$11.1 billion to the state's economy.
- Oregon's arts and cultural industries employed 70,137 workers. These workers earned wages and benefits totaling \$6.1 billion.
- 41.7% of Oregon's adults attended live music, theater, or dance performances, while 20.1% attended art exhibits.

The **Shakespeare in American Communities** program in Oregon enabled schools to offer **2,669** children the opportunity to see live professional performances of Shakespeare, or to engage in educational programs.

The program also offers community arts programming to improve the well-being and resilience of all military-connected people.
