In one year alone...

- Arts and cultural production in Texas added 2.5% or \$65.6 billion to the state's economy.
- Texas's arts and cultural industries employed 360,964 workers. These workers earned wages and benefits totaling \$32.0 billion.
- 39.7% of Texas's adults attended live music, theater, or dance performances, while 19.7% attended art exhibits.

The Blue Star Museums program provided free admission to thousands of active military personnel and their families at **399 participating museums** in Texas.

More than 3,252 students from 88 high schools in Texas participated in Poetry Out Loud.

The NEA Big Read program generated community events focused on reading outstanding American literature and involving more than 28,350 adults and students in Texas.



The Shakespeare in American Communities program in Texas enabled schools to offer 10,599 children the opportunity to see live professional performances of Shakespeare, or to engage in educational programs.
