In one year alone...

- Arts and cultural production in Vermont added
 2.9% or \$1.2 billion to the state's economy.
- Vermont's arts and cultural industries employed 10,412 workers. These workers earned wages and benefits totaling \$0.7 billion.
- 54.2% of Vermont's adults attended live music, theater, or dance performances, while 32.5% attended art exhibits.

The **Blue Star Museums** program provided free admission to thousands of active military personnel and their families at **59 participating museums** in Vermont.

More than **2,752 students** from **98 high schools** in Vermont participated in **Poetry Out Loud**.

The program also offers community arts programming to improve the well-being and resilience of all military-connected people.
