The National Endowment for the Arts distributed more than \$10,046,454 in grants in Alaska.





In one year alone...

- Arts and cultural production in Alaska added 2.2% or \$1.5 billion to the state's economy.
- Alaska's arts and cultural industries employed 13,291 workers. These workers earned wages and benefits totaling \$1 billion.
- 28.4% of Alaska's adults attended live music, theater, or dance performances, while 21.4% attended art exhibits.

The Blue Star Museums program provided free admission to thousands of active military personnel and their families at 23 participating museums in Alaska.

More than 2,861 students from 60 high schools in Alaska participated in Poetry Out Loud.

The NEA Big Read program generated community events focused on reading outstanding American literature and involving more than 1,150 adults and students in Alaska.



The Shakespeare in American Communities program in Alaska enabled schools to offer 24 children the opportunity to see live professional performances of Shakespeare, or to engage in educational programs.
