In one year alone...

- Arts and cultural production in Colorado added 3.7% or \$19.7 billion to the state's economy.
- Colorado's arts and cultural industries employed 121,228 workers. These workers earned wages and benefits totaling \$10.5 billion.
- 39.8% of Colorado's adults attended live music, theater, or dance performances, while 25.5% attended art exhibits.
