The National Endowment for the Arts distributed more than **\$24,614,118** in grants in **Florida**.

In one year alone...

- Arts and cultural production in Florida added
   3.2% or \$50.8 billion to the state's economy.
- Florida's arts and cultural industries employed 307,615 workers. These workers earned wages and benefits totaling \$24.3 billion.
- 31.6% of Florida's adults attended live music, theater, or dance performances, while 16.4% attended art exhibits.

#### **National Endowment for the Arts Programs**



The **Blue Star Museums** program provided free admission to thousands of active military personnel and their families at **205 participating museums** in Florida.



More than **8,674 students** from **168 high schools** in Florida participated in **Poetry Out Loud**.



The **NEA Big Read** program generated community events focused on reading outstanding American literature and involving more than **68,896** adults and students in Florida.



The **Shakespeare in American Communities** program in Florida enabled schools to offer **2,362** children the opportunity to see live professional performances of Shakespeare, or to engage in educational programs.



**Creative Forces** brings creative arts therapies to military personnel and veterans who are experiencing post-traumatic stress, mild traumatic brain injury, and related psychological illnesses. The program also offers community arts programming to improve the well-being and resilience of all military-connected people.
