In one year alone...

- Arts and cultural production in Georgia added
 3.8% or \$31.2 billion to the state's economy.
- Georgia's arts and cultural industries employed 164,919 workers. These workers earned wages and benefits totaling \$13.5 billion.
- 34.7% of Georgia's adults attended live music, theater, or dance performances, while 16.8% attended art exhibits.

The **Blue Star Museums** program provided free admission to thousands of active military personnel and their families at **105 participating museums** in Georgia.



More than **8,135 students** from **255 high schools** in Georgia participated in **Poetry Out Loud**.



The **NEA Big Read** program generated community events focused on reading outstanding American literature and involving more than **33,425** adults and students in Georgia.



The **Shakespeare in American Communities** program in Georgia enabled schools to offer **4,842** children the opportunity to see live professional performances of Shakespeare, or to engage in educational programs.



Creative Forces brings creative arts therapies to military personnel and veterans who are experiencing post-traumatic stress, mild traumatic brain injury, and related psychological illnesses. The program also offers community arts programming to improve the well-being and resilience of all military-connected people.
