- Arts and cultural production in Louisiana added
 2.1% or \$6.6 billion to the state's economy.
- Louisiana's arts and cultural industries employed 48,591 workers. These workers earned wages and benefits totaling \$3.3 billion.
- 36.5% of Louisiana's adults attended live music, theater, or dance performances, while 11.5% attended art exhibits.
