In one year alone...

- Arts and cultural production in Maine added 2.7% or \$2.5 billion to the state's economy.
- Maine's arts and cultural industries employed 18,073 workers. These workers earned wages and benefits totaling \$1.2 billion.
- 42.3% of Maine's adults attended live music, theater, or dance performances, while 15.1% attended art exhibits.

The **Blue Star Museums** program provided free admission to thousands of active military personnel and their families at 55 participating museums in Maine.

More than 4,705 students from 93 high schools in Maine participated in Poetry Out Loud.

The NEA Big Read program generated community events focused on reading outstanding American literature and involving more than 9,897 adults and students in Maine.



The Shakespeare in American Communities program in Maine enabled schools to offer 1,467 children the opportunity to see live professional performances of Shakespeare, or to engage in educational programs.
