### In one year alone...

- Arts and cultural production in Nevada added **5.1% or \$12.4 billion** to the state's economy.
- Nevada's arts and cultural industries employed **46,761** workers. These workers earned wages and benefits totaling **\$4.4 billion**.
- **34.8%** of Nevada's adults attended live music, theater, or dance performances, while **19.6%** attended art exhibits.

### National Endowment for the Arts Programs



The **Blue Star Museums** program provided free admission to thousands of active military personnel and their families at **46 participating museums** in Nevada.



More than **3,181 students** from **72 high schools** in Nevada participated in **Poetry Out Loud**.



The **NEA Big Read** program generated community events focused on reading outstanding American literature and involving more than **14,948** adults and students in Nevada.



**Creative Forces** brings creative arts therapies to military personnel and veterans who are experiencing post-traumatic stress, mild traumatic brain injury, and related psychological illnesses. The program also offers community arts programming to improve the well-being and resilience of all military-connected people.
