- Arts and cultural production in New Mexico added 2.6% or \$3.5 billion to the state's economy.
- New Mexico's arts and cultural industries employed 28,153 workers. These workers earned wages and benefits totaling \$1.9 billion.
- 36.4% of New Mexico's adults attended live music, theater, or dance performances, while 20.3% attended art exhibits.
