The Arts Endowment used the same formula to determine the amounts for the CARES Act funding as it does to determine amounts for the partnership agreements to these groups every year. The formula for award of the 40 percent share is Congressionally mandated and set forth in the agency's legislation.

Regarding the states' share of the 40 percent, three-quarters of that is awarded as follows: Each state begins with a base amount of \$200,000, then, any state with a population greater than 200,000 shares equally in the remainder.

The remaining one quarter of the 40 percent is awarded based upon Arts Endowment policy (also as provided in the Congressional mandate) with additional funding to the states and territories based upon population, and to the regional arts organizations and the National Assembly of State Arts Agencies.
